The guide explores how Vision Zero can be applied by companies in the environmental sector, by creating a systematic approach, based on the 7 Golden Rules, to contribute to a better environmental protection. The purpose of this guide is to serve as a reference on environmental management for those responsible for the implementation of Vision Zero.
